## Employee Campaign

Your participation in the employee campaign shows another level of your support for Maine Veterans and their eligible family members. As employees you help us fulfill our mission of Caring for those who served, and now as a donor you are also Giving for those who served. At our new home, we are establishing two areas to recognize our staff.

## Employee Donor Wall

All employees, regardless of donation level, will be recognized on our Employee Donor Wall. This wall will be installed in the Community Center at the new home. It will be located near the training room and the HR office where it will be easily accessible to all. On the employee donor wall you can list your name (and a spouse or significant other if you would like) Examples are John S. Doe or John and Marie Doe. If you would like to include your credentials or your rank, you are welcome to.

## Employee Brick/Paver Program

Located at the new Augusta Home, surrounding the flag poles, the Employee Brick/Paver area will be established to honor those employees that would like to make a special donation in honor or memory of a loved one. For a cash, payroll deduction, or EBT gift, employees can purchase a brick/paver in their choice of three different sizes. This will help you leave your mark on Maine's first Small Home long term care facility and be part of history.
