MVH Stakeholder Group

Pursuant to Maine Revised Statutes, Title 37-B, section 612, the MVH Board of Trustees, in collaboration with the Commissioner of Defense, Veterans and Emergency Management and the Commissioner of Health and Human Services, shall convene a group of relevant stakeholders to develop a plan for the long-term viability and continuous operation of the Homes across the state. The board will present the stakeholder group's findings and recommendations to the Joint Standing Committee of Veterans and Legal Affairs no later than February 15, 2023.
